## CSRT RECENT ACTIVITIES:

(THROUGH OCTOBER 2010)

- ◆ Abatements of Dangerous Buildings and Public Nuisances
- ◆ Active partner in Neighborhood Stabilization Program
- ◆ Various Safety Fair presentations
- ◆ Graffiti clean-up
- ◆ Coordination of return of abandoned shopping carts
- ◆ Presentations to local community organizations
- ◆ Business license renewal enforcement
- ◆ Working with local bars for effective violence and crime prevention and response
- ◆ Attendance and presentations at Neighborhood Association Meetings

## CSRT STATISTICS:

(FEBRUARY - OCTOBER 2010)

- ◆ Combined team (three Code Enforcement Officers, three Community Service Officers, one attorney, one paralegal and Police Lieutenant supervisor) started February, 2010.
- ◆ Approximately 300 active service requests, investigations, and enforcement actions.
- ◆ Attendance at numerous neighborhood association and other community meetings.
- ◆ 32 active and pending abatements (As of October 14, 2010)
- ◆ Approximately \$120,000 abatement liens placed in 2010 on properties for abatements of dangerous buildings.
- ◆ Approximately \$43,000 recovered from abatement liens in 2010.
