



NOISE

Common Noise Violations:

- **Horns/sirens except as a warning of danger**
- **Yelling or shouting on or near public streets that disturbs the peace**
- **Music from buildings that disturbs the peace**
- **Music from cars heard from 50 feet away**
- **Music from audio equipment**
 - 1) **heard from 50 feet away if public place, or**
 - 2) **50 feet away from the boundary of property if on private property.**
- **Squealing or other sounds from tires (except to avoid danger)**
- **Construction and residential maintenance noise (such as lawnmowers and power tools) outside the following times:**
 - 1) **M-F 7am-10pm**
 - 2) **Weekends 9am—10pm**

Noise regulations do not apply to:

- 1) **community events (between 9am-11pm)**
- 2) **regularly scheduled events at parks (between 9am-11pm)**
- 3) **lawfully discharged fireworks**
(restricted to July 3-5, 11am-11pm, Dec. 31, 11pm-Jan 1, 1am or as specially permitted)
