RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT

CAMP MURRAY NEW ENTRY CONTROL POINT/MAIN GATE

A right-of-way permit application has been filed with the City of Lakewood Community Development and Public Works Departments. The following is a description of the application and the process for review. APPLICATION NAME: Camp Murray New Entry Control Point/Main Gate

PROPOSED PROJECT ACTION: The State Military Department proposes to close the existing gate (excepting for heavy truck traffic) located on Militia Drive SW and construct a new gate at the northeastern portion of Camp Murray near the intersection of Portland Avenue SW and Boundary Street SW in the City of Lakewood's Tillicum community. The proposed action is to connect the new gate to the City of Lakewood public road system. This action requires issuance of a City of Lakewood right-of-way permit. The community development director and public works director have the authority to approve, deny, modify and/or condition the permit application.

Any person or agency commenting on the right-of-way permit should include a request to receive a copy of the permit decision once it is made.

Any aggrieved person or agency may appeal the decision on this application by filing an appeal with the city clerk within 14 calendar days of the date of decision. The appeal shall be accompanied with the appropriate fee as established by city resolution (\$450). The appeal fee must be paid upon filing of the notice of appeal.
